2. The applicant has been accepted to a technical school, 2 year college or 4 year college.
3. The applicant has graduated the current year from high school with at least a 2.5 GPA (grade point average).
4. Applications may be picked up at the Senior Fairboard Office or online at www.darkecountyfair.com, starting July 1st.
5. Completed applications are due to the Senior Fairboard Office, August 1st.
6. Please attach a high school transcript.
7. ***Two letters of recommendation, with at least one being from a 4-H or FFA advisor, must be attached to the application.***
8. Number of Scholarships and amounts are to be determined.
9. Winner(s) will be announced prior to the goat sale at the fair. Money will be distributed following the September Goat Committee meeting.
