Per the March 5, 2014 Board Meeting minutes, departments and vendors are not permitted to be released until 11 p.m. on the last Saturday of the Fair unless another event is scheduled to take place in their area. 2023 Agriculture Department exhibits will be released and premiums will be disbursed between 1 p.m. and 3 p.m. on Sunday, August 27, 2023, Early removal of exhibits will result in forfeiture of premiums. Bring exhibitor ticket when claiming exhibits and premiums.
- All produce or articles inferior in quality or age will be disqualified or eliminated or not accepted for exhibit.
- 7. All entries, or any part thereof, must remain on exhibit until the payment of premiums has been made.
- 8. All produce and articles without competition will be awarded first money only, if in the judgment of the committee, said produce and articles are worthy.
